You are hereby notified that I have amended Provisional Certificate of Approval No. A220112 issued on October 8, 1992 for a Waste Disposal Site (Landfill), as follows:

- I. The following condition is hereby added:
- (53) For the period of January 13, 2003 until January 21, 2003, the Site may accept, process and transfer used Christmas Trees on Site during normal operational hours.
- II. The following item is hereby amended to Schedule "A":
- (53) Letter dated January 7, 2003 from Andrew Pollock, Director of Waste Management, The Region of Peel to John Budz, MOE, District Manager, Halton-Peel District Office, re: Emergency Amendment to the Certificate of Approval at the Brittania Sanitary Landfill Site.

The reason for this amendment to the Certificate of Approval is as follows:

To allow the Region to process Christmas Trees for a one week period at the Site due to breakdowns at other facilities.

This Notice shall constitute part of the approval issued under Provisional Certificate of Approval No. A220112 dated October 8, 1992

In accordance with Section 139 of the Environmental Protection Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter E-19, as amended, you may by written notice served upon me and the Environmental Review Tribunal within 15 days after receipt of this Notice, require a hearing by the Tribunal. Section 142 of the Environmental Protection Act, provides that the Notice requiring the hearing shall state:

- 1. The portions of the approval or each term or condition in the approval in respect of which the hearing is required, and;
- 2. The grounds on which you intend to rely at the hearing in relation to each portion appealed.

The Notice should also include:

- 3. The name of the appellant;
- 4. The address of the appellant;
- 5. The Certificate of Approval number;
- 6. The date of the Certificate of Approval;
- 7. The name of the Director;
- 8. The municipality within which the waste disposal site is located;

And the Notice should be signed and dated by the appellant.
