You are hereby notified that I have amended Provisional Certificate of Approval No. A680110 issued on April 18, 1996 and amended on November 21, 1996 for a Waste Disposal Site (Transfer/Processing) receiving a maximum of 160,368 tonnes/year of waste and storing a maximum quantity of 2,047 tonnes of waste at any time, as follows:

Definitions

The following definitions are hereby revoked and replaced:

- (a) "**Act**" or "**EPA**" means the Environmental Protection Act, R. S. O. 1990, c. E.19, as amended;
- (b) "**Applicant**" means Northwood Recycling and Energy Inc., its successors and assigns;
- (c) "**District Manager**" means the District Manager of the local district office of the Ministry in which the Site is geographically located;
- (d) "**Ministry**" means the Ministry of the Environment;
- (e) "**Director**" means any Ministry employee appointed in writing by the Minister pursuant to section 5 of the EPA as a Director for the purposes of Part V of the EPA;

The following definitions are hereby added:

- (h) "**Certificate**" means this entire Provisional Certificate of Approval document, issued in accordance with section 39 of the EPA, and includes any schedules to it, the application and the supporting documentation listed in Schedule "A";
- (i) "**Guideline F-15**" or "**Financial Assurance Guideline**" means the Financial Assurance Guideline, Guideline F-15, issued by the Ministry in November 2005 under the authority of the EPA;
- (j) "**Owner**" means any person that is responsible for the establishment or operation of the Site, and includes Northwood Recycling and Energy Inc., its successors and assigns;
- (k) "**Provincial Officer**" means any person designated in writing by the Minister as a provincial officer pursuant to section 5 of the Ontario Water Resources Act or section 5 of the EPA or section 17 of the Pesticides Act;
- (l) "**Regional Director**" means the Regional Director of the local Regional Office of the Ministry in which the Site is located;
- (m) "**Reg. 347**" or "**Regulation 347**" means Regulation 347 General - Waste Management, R.R.O. 1990, made under the Environmental Protection Act, as amended from time to time.

Financial Assurance

Condition (35) (b) and (c) are hereby revoked and replaced:

(35) (b) By April 30, 2009, the Owner shall prepare and submit to the Director a new Financial Assurance calculation for this Site. The monetary value of the Financial Assurance shall be calculated in accordance with Guideline F-15, section 6.5 "*Estimating Financial Assurance when the planning period is less than four years or when there is no known future date for closure, clean-up or remediation expenditures (No discounting)*" and section 6.6, as applicable.

(c) Upon acceptance of the Director of the new Financial Assurance required under Condition 35. (b) above, the Owner shall adjust (increase or decrease accordingly) the Financial Assurance amount provided under Condition 35. (a) (\$69,564). The revised Financial Assurance shall be submitted within twenty (20) days of the Director's acceptance of the calculation.

Schedule "A"

The following item is hereby added to Schedule "A":

(41) Letter dated December 11, 2008 from Mr. Harvey Ambrose, Courtice Auto Wreckers Limited to Mr Tes Gebrezghi, EAAB, Ministry of the Environment requesting a name change from Courtice Auto Wreckers Limited to Northwood Recycling and Energy Inc., and attaching corporate documents showing that Mr. Harvey Ambrose is the legal owner of both subject companies.

The reasons for this amendment to the Certificate of Approval are as follows:

- 1. The Director has accepted the Owner's request to change the Owner's name as shown in this amendment.*
- 2. The definitions have been revised to update the language of this Certificate to be consistent with modern usage.*
- 3. Condition (35) has been revised so that the Owner may calculate the Financial Assurance, which has not been re-calculated for many years, in accordance with current rules for such calculations (Guideline F-15).*

This Notice shall constitute part of the approval issued under Provisional Certificate of Approval No. A680110 dated April 18, 1996 and amended.

In accordance with Section 139 of the Environmental Protection Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter E-19, as amended, you may by

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written notice served upon me and the Environmental Review Tribunal within 15 days after receipt of this Notice, require a hearing by the Tribunal. Section 142 of the Environmental Protection Act, provides that the Notice requiring the hearing shall state:

1. The portions of the approval or each term or condition in the approval in respect of which the hearing is required, and;
2. The grounds on which you intend to rely at the hearing in relation to each portion appealed.

The Notice should also include:

3. The name of the appellant;
4. The address of the appellant;
5. The Certificate of Approval number;
6. The date of the Certificate of Approval;
7. The name of the Director;
8. The municipality within which the waste disposal site is located;

And the Notice should be signed and dated by the appellant.
